



McLeod Dam

Dam Information and History

Constructed in 1979, this dam is located on the Moira River in the City of Belleville, about 200m upstream of the College Street crossing. This dam is one of six ice control dams. The dam was built to provide a storage area to prevent ice sheets from moving downstream into the City proper. It was updated in 2007 to also produce hydro-electricity.

Dam Safety

Always exercise caution when boating, hiking or fishing near dams.

Stay off the dam structures unless the area is clearly marked for public travel.

Be alert to changes in water levels.

Read and pay attention to warning signs near dams.
