



Skootamatta Dam

Dam Information and History

The Skootamatta Lake Dam is located on the Skootamatta River system, which is a tributary of the Moira River, in the Township of Addington Highlands.

The primary purpose of the dam is the control of the lake water levels for recreational and fish and wildlife benefits.

It also provides low-flow augmentation and flood control in the Skootamatta River. This dam is owned by the MNR and is operated by Quinte Conservation.

Dam Safety

Always exercise caution when boating, hiking or fishing near dams.

Stay off the dam structures unless the area is clearly marked for public travel.

Be alert to changes in water levels.

Read and pay attention to warning signs near dams.
