- Be the front line at conservation areas throughout the watershed
- Provide daily and seasonal parking passes to guests at conservation areas

- Comfortable with using power tools, pruners, and weed trimmers. Chainsaw experience is an asset
- Valid Ontario Driver's license
- Experience working in inclement conditions (heat, rain, biting insects)
- Ability to work near water
